Refund Policy

☐ Tuition is refunded in full within three (3) business days after the signed agreement, except for the application and other fees. Should a student decide to drop out or leave for military duties, the student must do so in writing. Upon receiving the written request, tuition will be refunded on a prorated scale based on the number of days lapsed passed the three days mark. All materials obtained from Cornerstone Christian University must be returned as they were received.

TERM-END CONTINUATION FEES

☐ Acknowledgement

Continuation is defined by the duration after the date determining the end of a Study Cycle. CUF imposes a continuation fee on each student who overstays the duration of their program. For example, a student has the following time frame to complete his/her degree:

1. Bachelor, 4 years and Bachelor with Prior Learning, 2 or 3 years
2. Masters, 2 years and Masters with Prior Learning, 1 year
3. Doctorate, 3 years and doctorate with Prior Learning, 2- ½ years

If after the required time frame, a student is unable to complete his/her program, he/she must request an extension to continue. **This extension is called continuation.** The Academics Department may issue an extension based on the need of the individual student. The student must request an extension from the Academic Department office 90 days before the end of the duration of his/her program ends. The fee per extension is \$350 for a bachelor's; \$750 for a master and \$1000 for a doctorate. We discourage students to linger to the point of requiring an extension. With proper planning, anyone can complete their program in less time than needed. Please note: follow the above requirement closely to prevent your file to be closed, which will add another reopening fee.

Disclaimer

☐ CCU is not a Title 4 school. Therefore, students are not eligible for Federal funding. Since CCU is not a Title 4, Title 4 may not accept credits from CCU.
